



Dear Food Freedom Families,

Our goal at the Southern California Food Allergy Institute is for all children who suffer from food allergies to safely eat whatever they want, whenever they want. The Tolerance Induction Program (TIP)[™] at SoCal Food Allergy has allowed thousands of children, and their families, achieve this goal.

We ask our prospective families to review and acknowledge the associated costs of the Tolerance Induction Program before enrolling in the program.

Tolerance Induction Program (TIP) Fee

The annual fee charged to families for each child enrolled in the program is \$4,500.00. This amount is billed in quarterly installments of \$1,125.00 per child, or \$375.00 per month. The first quarterly installment is due at the time of scheduling your initial appointment; thereafter, you will be billed quarterly [every three (3) months] for the duration the child participates in the program. This fee covers on-call support and maintenance of your food dosing strategy (developed by the provider). This fee is an out-of-pocket expense that is not billable to insurance and is separate from any associated office visit/diagnostic testing costs.

Diagnostic Testing Costs and Visit Fees

During your introductory visit you will meet with a physician from our team who will review your child's medical history, conduct skin and patch tests, and order required laboratory tests. Other testing may be required depending on your child's specific care plan.

Visit and diagnostic testing fees may be covered by your health insurance plan, less any applicable out-of-pocket expenses (i.e., copayments, coinsurances, deductibles). Please contact your insurance carrier for a summary of benefits.

The anticipated costs are as follows:

- **Teleboarding visit:** \$95.00
 - An in depth review of your child's medical and food allergy history along with the opportunity to ask a physician questions you may have regarding TIP.
- **Onboarding Visit** (at a minimum includes the following):
 - Blood draw through Foundation Labs: \$2,500.00; a deposit is required at the time of the lab appointment as follows:
 - \$500.00 for Private Insurance (i.e., PPO, EPO, POS)
 - \$1,000.00 for Self-Pay and HMO (i.e., self-elected Self-Pay)

- \$2,500.00 for International Patient
 - The balance is due four (4) months from the onboarding appointment date
- Consultation visit: \$450.00
- Skin test: \$2,000.00 (depending on the total number of allergens)
 - \$50.00 per food allergen
- Patch test: \$1,000.00 (depending on the total number of allergens)
 - \$25.00 per allergen
- Pulmonary Function Testing (for children 7 years & up)
 - Spirometry \$120.00
 - Exhaled Nitric Oxide Test (eNO): \$40.00

After the initial Onboarding visit, SoCal Food Allergy estimates an additional eight (8) office visits/food challenges per year; estimated cost of \$3840.00 for the year.

- **Office Visits/Food Challenges** (at a minimum includes the following):
 - Office Visit: \$240.00
 - Food Challenge: \$195.00

Additional costs may include the following and/or any services added to any visit (as needed):

- SLIT(if applicable) - \$280.00-\$320.00 every three-four (3-4) months (NON billable to insurance)
- Skin Test: \$50.00 per allergen tested
- Patch Test: \$25.00 per allergen tested
- Pulmonary Function Testing (for children 7 years & up)
 - Spirometry \$120.00
 - Exhaled Nitric Oxide Test (eNO): \$40.00

Remission Fees

Once your child achieves remission, annual TIP™ fees will be reduced to \$375.00 which constitutes the annual Remission Fee. The Remission Fee is billed and payable once a year.

Additionally, an Annual Remission Visit will include the following costs:

- In-person or Telehealth appointment: \$240.00 per visit
- Blood draw through Foundation Labs: \$2,500.00 (deposit required)
- Skin test: \$2,000.00 (depending on the total number of allergens)
 - \$50.00 per food allergen
- Pulmonary Function Testing (for children 7 years & up)
 - Spirometry \$120.00



- Exhaled Nitric Oxide Test (eNO): \$40.00
- Food Challenge: \$195.00
 - Maybe recommend based off of lab analysis

Applicable copay and coinsurance apply. Diagnostic testing costs and visit fees may be covered by your insurance plan.

HMO Patients

A referral or authorization is required for all HMO patients, an appointment will not be scheduled until one is received by our billing office. Please contact your Primary Care Physician (PCP) to initiate the request for services. Please provide your PCP with our provider information:
