Construction at Vista Grande Court in Glendale is on schedule and looking great! With the roof up, cabinets installed, and sidewalks prepped for concrete, the building is 70% complete.

Project Manager Ana Tapia is thrilled that LINC's first construction project in the city has gone so smoothly. "The City of Glendale has been a great partner. They've been very involved in moving the process along and given incredible support." Construction partner National CORE has also been invaluable. "CORE staff have been true professionals every step of the way, from design and permitting to construction," Tapia reports.

Mosaic Gardens at Westlake has been honored by some of the most prestigious institutions in the industry. The downtown LA community [recently won](#) the 2019 American Institute of Architects|LA Residential Architecture "Honor" Award in the Affordable Housing category. The jurors noted that the 125-unit building shows "how you can make affordable housing beautiful and stunning and yet also warm and vibrant for the residents living there."

Westlake was also honored with the 2019 Gold Nugget Award for Best Affordable Housing Community (60 du/acre or more). LINC President and CEO Rebecca Clark and COO Suny Lay Chang accepted the [award](#).
